In response to COVID-19 Banner Pharmacy Services would like to take every measure to ensure patients are able to stay home. Below is a list of pharmacies that will deliver medications. Please indicate on the prescription patient would like medications to be delivered.

## **Please Note:**

- AHCCCS and some Medicare part B plans typically do not cover home delivery.
  - o Insurances are expected to allow medication delivery during the COVID-19 outbreak response
- Some pharmacies may not have the capability to deliver refrigerated products. Controlled substances may have restrictions and/or require an ID and signature for delivery.
- Some local stores may offer delivery of OTC supplies as well as prescriptions.
- The pharmacy website and/or app will let the patient know if their prescription is eligible.

CVS	<ul> <li>Free 1 to 2-day shipping from March 9<sup>th</sup> to May 1, 2020.</li> <li>Option 1: Patients receive a text message notice that refills are ready from their local store and will receive a link to set up an account for deliver and online payment of the refill</li> <li>Option 2: Download CVS app and sign up for home delivery through app.</li> <li>Patients can call their local CVS for help.</li> </ul>
Banner Family Pharmacy	<ul> <li>Free delivery within approximately 5 to 10 days.</li> <li>Patients need to enroll at the following website:         https://access.bannerhealth.com/PharmacyHomeDelivery     </li> <li>Patients can call 602-747-6441 with any questions.</li> </ul>
Costco Pharmacy	<ul> <li>Free standard shipping (allow at least 4 business days) on orders over \$75, otherwise \$4.99 delivery fee.</li> <li>Patient can sign up for delivery and payment by going to: pharmacy.costco.com</li> </ul>
Fry's and Safeway	<ul> <li>Most stores offer local next day delivery within a limited radius of the stores.</li> <li>Call store for refills and arrange for payment over the phone for the prescriptions and delivery fee.</li> <li>Fry's – delivery fee of \$6</li> <li>Safeway – delivery fee of \$8, could be more if delivery is over 10 miles from the pharmacy</li> </ul>
Walgreens	<ul> <li>Free delivery from local store.</li> <li>Patients must sign up for texting plan from Walgreens. Walgreens will send patients a link and will tell them if their prescription is eligible and next steps.</li> <li>Patients can call local Walgreens for help.</li> </ul>
Postal Prescription Services - PPS	<ul> <li>Free delivery within approximately 5 to 7 days.</li> <li>Patients need to enroll by calling 1-800-552-6694. Then select option 2 – Customer Service, followed by option 2 – New Customer</li> </ul>
