Paroxysmal Afib	I48.0	Indicate fibrillation vs. flutter, paroxysmal, persistent, chronic, typical or atypical

Infarction	code	Tip
ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction involving left main coronary artery	I21.01	Indicate acute (less than 4 weeks old) or Old; wall and artery involved; STEMI or Non-STEMI; initial or subsequent MI (within 4 weeks of initial)
Non-ST elevation (NSTEMI) myocardial infarction	I21.4	
Subsequent ST elevation (STEMI) myocardial infarction of inferior wall	I22.1	
CAD	Code	Tip
Atherosclerosis of autologous vein coronary artery bypass graft(s) with unstable angina pectoris	I25.710	Indicate native or bypassed graft (type of graft used); with or without angina
Atherosclerotic heart disease of native coronary artery without angina pectoris	I25.10	
Atherosclerotic heart disease of native coronary artery with angina pectoris with documented spasm	I25.111	
CHF	Code	Tip
Acute Systolic CHF	I50.21	Indicate systolic, diastolic, or combined and acute, chronic or acute on chronic
Chronic Diastolic CHF	I50.32	
Acute on chronic combined CHF	I50.43	
Chronic Systolic CHF	I50.22	
Acute Diastolic CHF	I50.31	
Mitral Stenosis	Code	Tip
Rheumatic Mitral stenosis	I05.0	Rheumatic and non rheumatic are in different categories
Nonrheumatic mitral (valve)stenosis	I34.2	
Heart Block	Code	Tip
Atrioventricular block, second degree	I44.1	Indicate AV (first, second, or third degree) or Bundle Branch (left or right, anterior or posterior fascicular); type

Left anterior fascicular block	I44.4
Left bundle-branch block, unspecified	I44.7

* Indicate Episode of Care (initial, subsequent, sequela) for injuries or fractures

* Always indicate left, right or bilateral
