Right lower quadrant rebound abdominal tenderness	R10.823

Calculus of gallbladder with acute cholecystitis w/o obstruction	K80.00	Indicate with or without obstruction, acute, chronic or both
Calculus of gallbladder w/o cholecystitis with obstruction	K80.21	
Calculus of bile duct with acute cholecystitis w/o obstruction	K80.42	
Calculus of gallbladder and bile duct with chronic cholecystitis with obstruction	K80.65

Irritable bowel syndrome with diarrhea	K58.0	Indicate with or without diarrhea
Irritable bowel syndrome without diarrhea	K58.9	
POLYPS	Code	Tip
Inflammatory polyps of colon with intestinal obstruction	K51.412	Indicate with or without bleeding, indicate complication, such as, abscess, fistula, obstruction
Polyp of colon	K63.5	
Benign neoplasm of colon, unspecified	D12.6	
ULCER	Code	Tip
Acute gastric ulcer with	K25.0	Indicate with or without hemorrhage, with or without perforation
Chronic gastric ulcer without	K25.7
